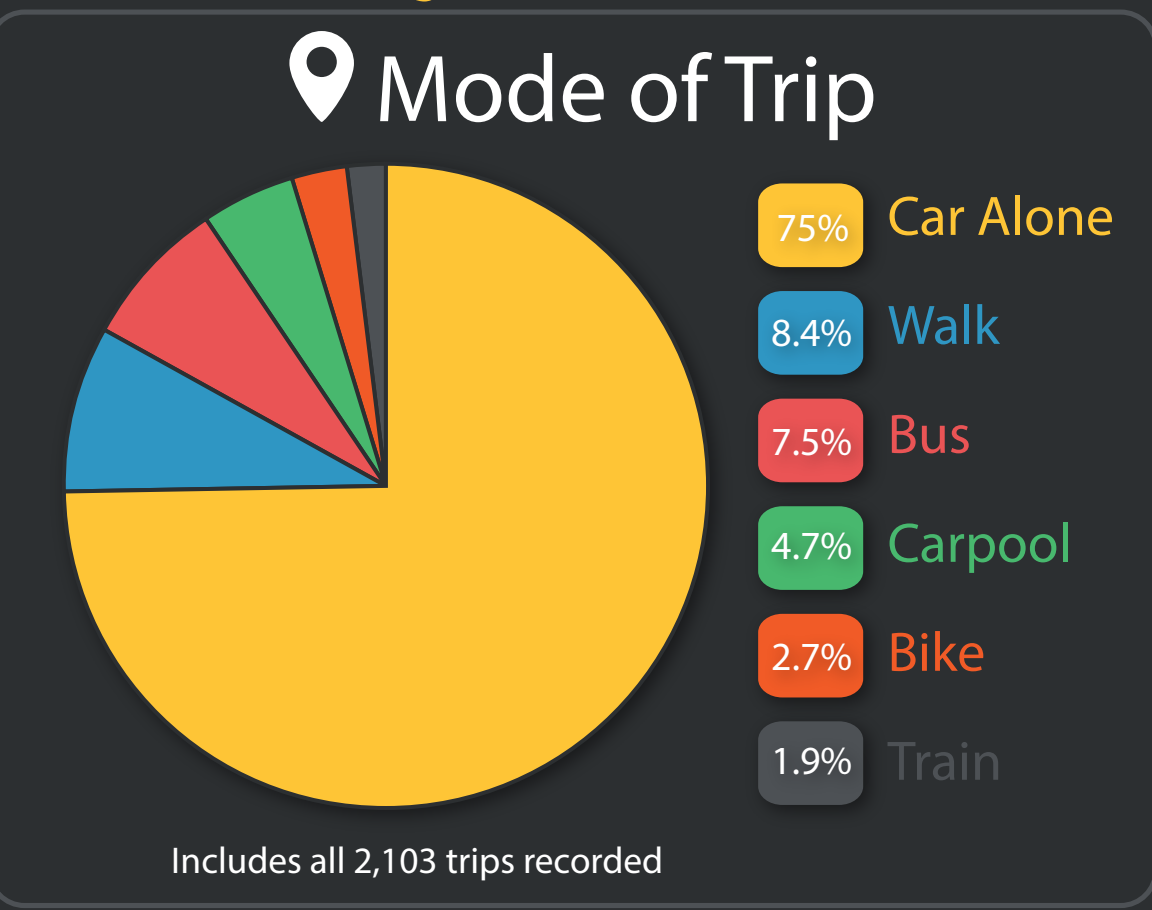


What was the O-D study?

O-D stands for origin and destination. We wanted to better understand where people are coming from and going to, to provide our planners a better picture of how transportation resources are being used. This was the first survey of its kind done by TCRPC. We collected responses from November 4th to January 31st.

How do we get there?



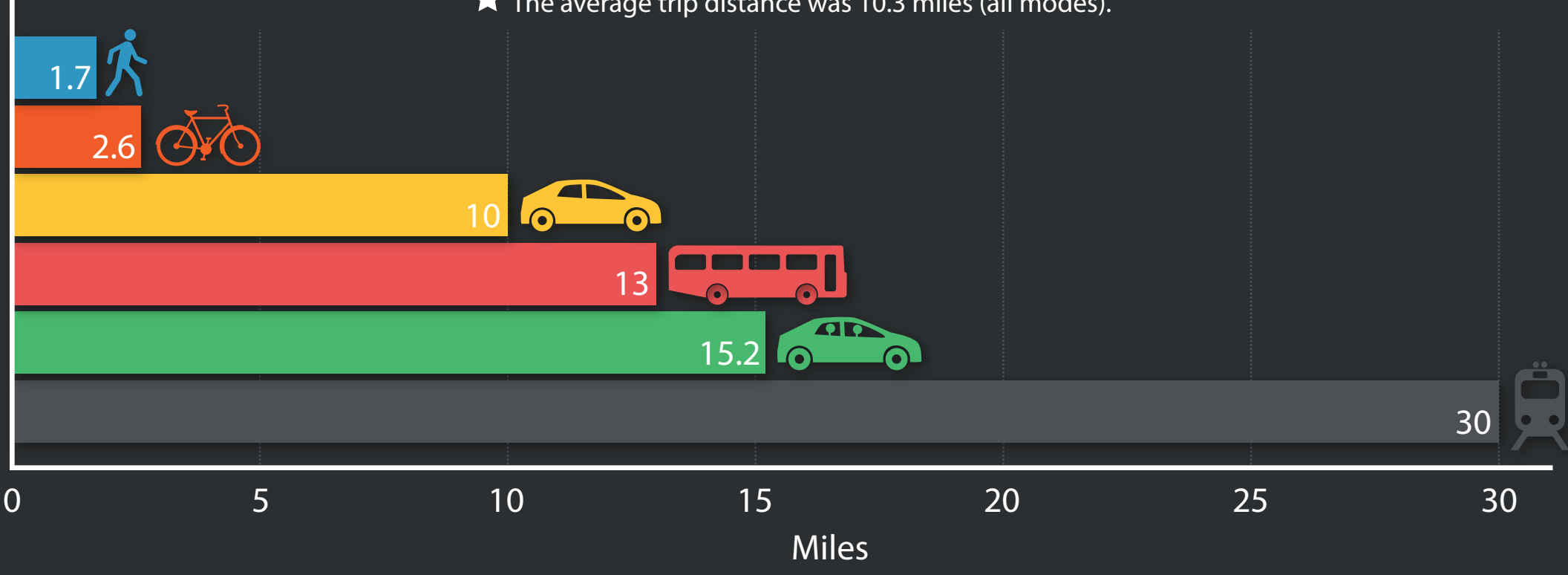
How will the data be used?

The results will become part of our travel demand model, which will estimate how many car and transit trips are being made and which road segments are being used during these trips.

★ The average trip distance was 10.3 miles (all modes).

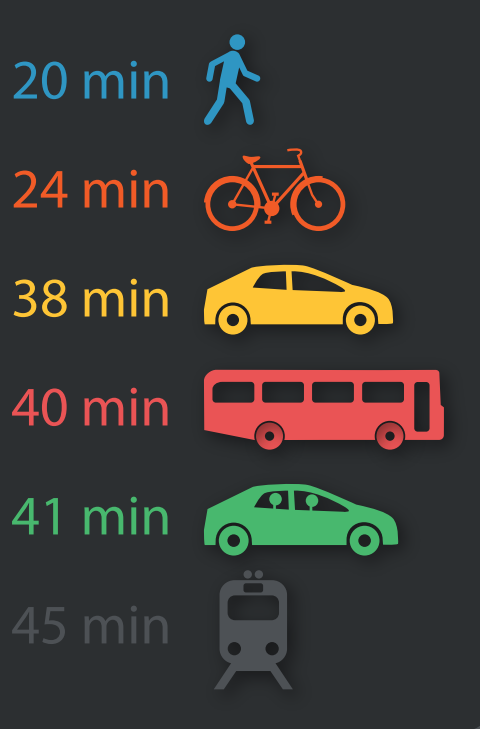
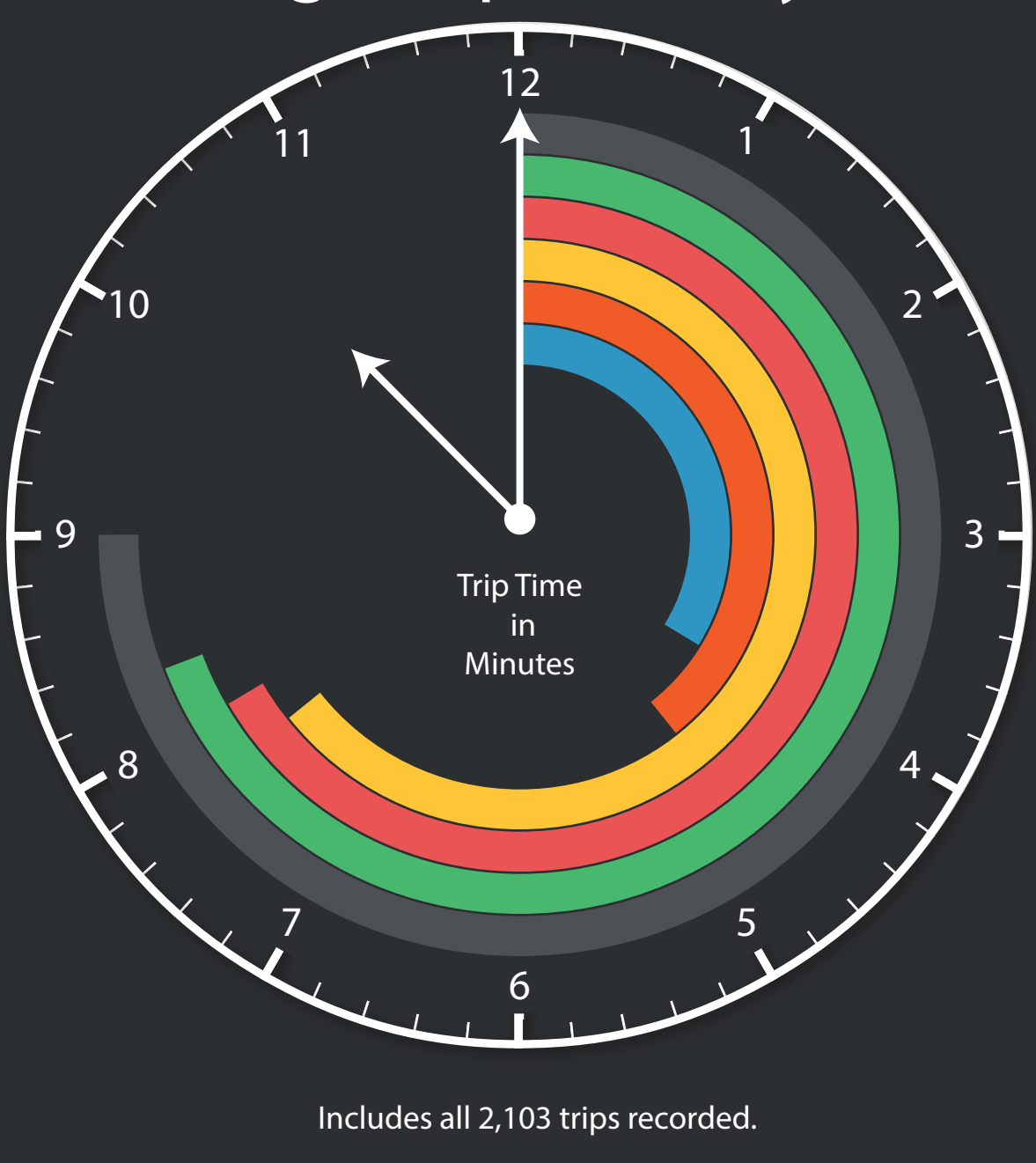


How long does it take?

How will this data help?

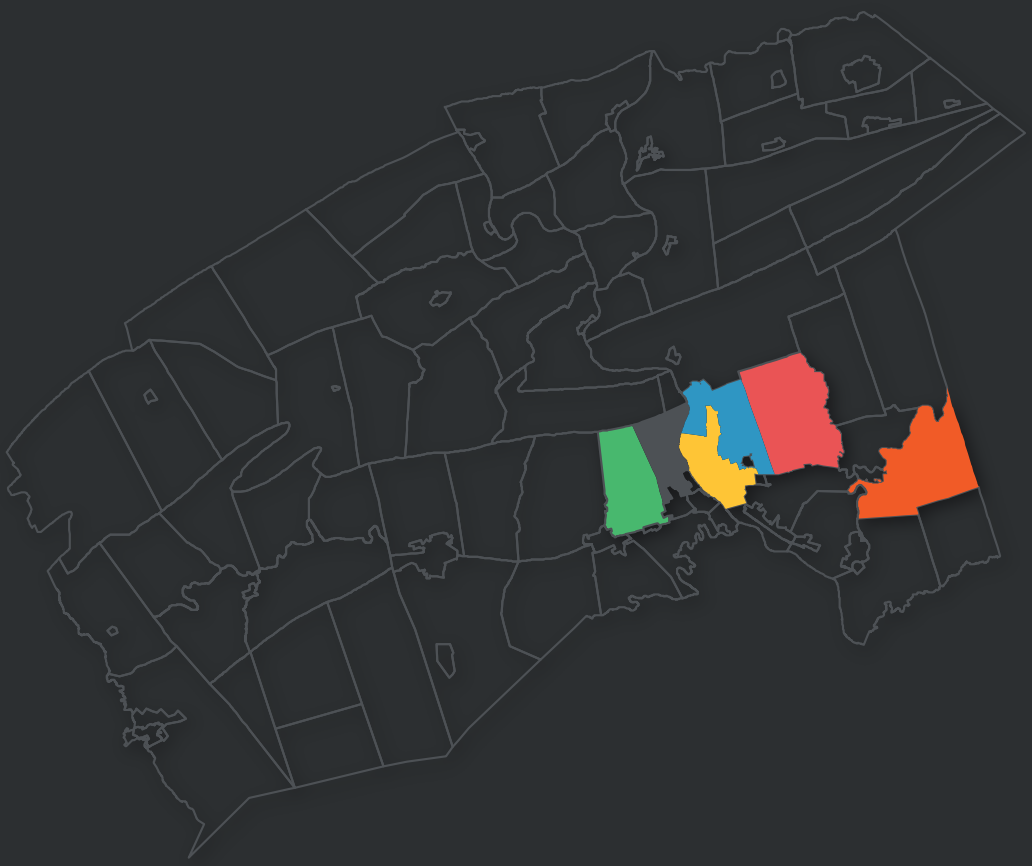
As TCRPC updates its Regional Transportation Plan, this information will give planners a better understanding of travel behaviors among commuters and reveal how different transportation systems are being used.

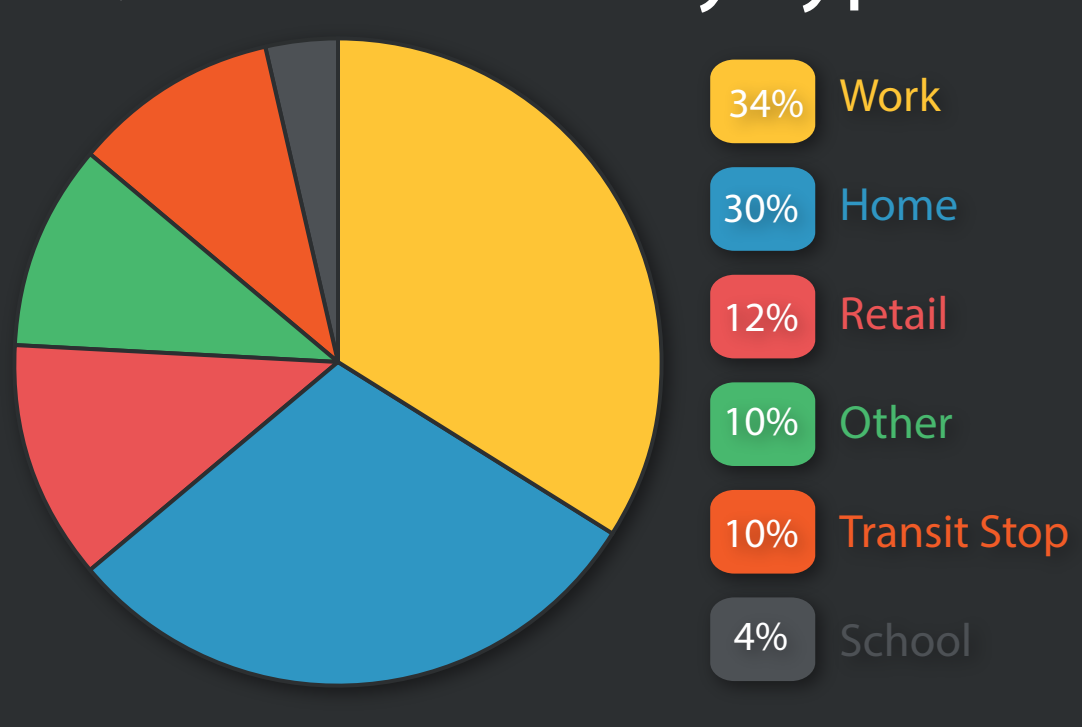
Trip Destinations
